Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Sand Lake adopted its Preliminary Budget on October 30, 2019; and

Whereas, the Town Board held a Public Hearing on the 2020 Preliminary Budget on October 30, 2019; and

Whereas, the Budget Officer of the Town of Sand Lake completed and filed the required online Property Tax Cap Form with the New York State Comptroller's Office on October 31, 2019 indicating that the Town of Sand Lake's 2020 Preliminary Budget does not override the tax cap; now therefore

Be it Resolved, the Town Board of the Town of Sand Lake hereby adopts the 2020 Preliminary Budget as the Town of Sand Lake 2020 Final Budget; and

Be it Further Resolved, that when final budgets are received from the fire districts, the Budget Officer will include final budget information on the Summary of the 2020 Town Budget page; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Town Clerk is directed to prepare two certified copies of the budget with certified copies of the fire districts' final budgets annexed to each and within five (5) days deliver the copies to the Town Supervisor, who must then present them to the Rensselaer County Legislature within ten (10) days of receipt.

Whereas, the Town of Sand Lake Town Board (the "Town Board") identified the need to review the 2006 Comprehensive Plan and 2011 Hamlets Linkage Study to properly plan for growth and development in Town; and

Whereas, a new Comprehensive Plan – the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan – has been prepared with the assistance of the planning consultant team of Laberge Group and Elan Planning, Design and Landscape Architecture; and

Whereas, the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan incorporates relevant sections of the 2006 Plan and 2011 Linkage Study, and was prepared with extensive public input including a public open house, design workshop, several stakeholder meetings and a public informational meeting to present the Draft Plan and accept comments; and

Whereas, the Town Board is now initiating the adoption process per Section 272-a of New York Town Law; and

Whereas, the Town of Sand Lake is duly qualified to act as Lead Agency for compliance with SEQRA which requires environmental review of certain actions undertaken by local governments and in accordance with the coordinated review procedures of SEQRA, the Town of Sand Lake Town Board wishes to be designated as the SEQRA Lead Agency for the proposed Project; and

Whereas, adoption of the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan (the "Proposed Action") pursuant to New York Town Law 272-a has been determined to be a Type 1 Action, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) 6 NYCRR Part 617.4; and

Whereas, the Town Board must refer the proposed 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan to the Rensselaer County Economic Development and Planning Department for review pursuant to New York General Municipal Law Section 239-m; and

Whereas, the Town Board is prepared to schedule a public hearing on the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan; now therefore

Be it Resolved, that the Town of Sand Lake hereby indicates its wish to be Lead Agency for SEQRA review of the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Town Board of the Town of Sand Lake authorizes and directs the Town of Sand Lake's Planner to send a copy of the Full Environmental Assessment Form Part 1 presented at this meeting, along with a certified copy of this resolution stating that the Town of Sand Lake's intention to be declared as Lead Agency, to the New York State Department of State as an identified involved agency in accordance with New York Town Law; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Town of Sand Lake hereby directs Laberge Group to prepare the Full Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) pursuant to the requirements set forth in SEQRA 6 NYCRR Part 617; and

Be it Further Resolved, the Town Board is hereby referring the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan to the Rensselaer County Economic Development and Planning Department for review pursuant to New York General Municipal Law Section 23-m; and

Be it Further Resolved, pursuant to Section 272-a(6) of New York Town Law, the Town of Sand Lake Town Board is scheduling a public hearing on December 11, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. to accept public comments on the 2019 Town of Sand Lake Comprehensive Plan; and
